

## **Instructions for authors *The Journal of the Norwegian Medical Association***

### **Papers submitted to the series 'Global Health in the Era of Agenda 2030'**

The papers submitted for publication in the planned NORAD/Centre for Global Health at the University of Oslo -series on global health topics will be reviewed for publication in the "comments"-section as "chronicles". Our chronicles are well argued opinions or analysis about important matters. These texts are more popularized and have a freer structure than traditional research papers published in medical journals.

The papers can be submitted for publication in the planned series after having passed the review in the expression of interest to the Secretariat at the Centre for Global Health, UiO. Please mark your submission with the name of the call.

### **How to structure your article**

The title should be kept short and not too specific and preferably inspire and trigger the curiosity of the reader. The text itself should start with a short, to the point preamble, max.60 words. You can structure the article as you want, but try to break up intersections with subheadings to enhance the readability.

The word limit is set to 2500 words including title, references and additional content. Try to keep your list of references short, preferably not more than 20-30, and please structure them according to the Vancouver-style. Manuscripts intended for publication in other scientific genres, including original scientific paper and reviews, might also be considered for inclusion in the series. In that case, please contact the editorial offices. Feel free to include figures, pictures and tables.

Our copy editors will proofread the texts, and our visual editor and illustrator will help you redraw and optimize figures, pictures and tables. Our illustrators also make designated illustrations for some of the articles.

### **Authorship**

Only authors who have participated in the work process with the article to the extent that they can take public responsibility for the content are counted as authors. Only authors who fulfill all of the three following criteria are counted: a) notable contribution to idea or formation or the acquisition or analysis of data, b) the composition of the content or critical review of it, and c) approval of publication. Our journal is committed to the ICMJE (International Committee of Medical Journal Editors) and the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) statutes and guidelines. All authors have to disclaim conflicts of interest on a dedicated form ([http://www.icmje.org/downloads/coi\\_disclosure.pdf](http://www.icmje.org/downloads/coi_disclosure.pdf)) which must be submitted along with the manuscript.

The journal is edited according to the statutes in "Redaktørplakaten" (<http://tidsskriftet.no/annet/redaktorplakaten>).

### **Publication ethics**

In cases where patients are mentioned, please note that we only accept strictly anonymized descriptions. The respective patients must also provide a written consent which are not to be submitted but kept in a secure place, preferably in the medical record (please contact the journal for provision of a specific form). We do not accept unpublished data in the manuscripts.

### **How to submit the article**

Make sure that the front page contains the following information <http://tidsskriftet.no/annet/folgebrev>:

- the title of the manuscript
- the names of the authors, addresses, place of employment and positions plus email address and phone number for corresponding author
- A very short biography of each author (birth year, position, titles)
- Make sure to attach a cover letter to the submission (why should people read about this topic now?)
- Please inform us in the cover letter if you have passed the internal review in the expression of interest at the Secretariat at the Centre for Global Health, UiO
- If reproduced pictures, figures etc. are submitted please attach permission to use

All accepted articles will be proofread by out copy editors. You will receive a copy before publication. It is of paramount importance that you as an author read through the text and look specifically at numbers, tables, figures and illustrations and correct any errors. You as an author are responsible for the content in your article (<http://tidsskriftet.no/annet/forfatterkorrektur>).
