Personnel and pregnancy in KPM

- You need to inform your immediate superior as soon as you know you are pregnant or suspect pregnancy, or if you are planning pregnancy (men and women).
- One is recommended not to enter KPM without first undergoing an extensive risk assessment due to exposure to allergens, hazardous drugs and chemicals and potential exposure to opportunist and pathogens.
- BHT (the Occupational Health Service) will give counsel for pregnancy at work.
