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Accidental puncturing /cutting with spontaneous bleeding.

- 1. Let it bleed, squeeze carefully.
- 2. Wash and rinse the injury with water and soap for 10 min.
- 3. Disinfect with chlorhexidin alcohol 5mg/mL or alternatively disinfection alcohol.

## Accidental puncturing /cutting without bleeding.

- 1. Do not squeeze, do not provoke bleeding.
- 2. Wash and rinse the injury with soap and water for 10 min
- 3. Disinfect with chlorhexidin alcohol 5mg/mL or possibly disinfection alcohol.

## Spray of blood in the eyes or on mucous membrane (nose/mouth)

1. Rinse immediately with excess physiological salt water or plain water for 10 min.

Spill of blood into wounds or scratches/fissures in the skin.

- 1. Rinse immediately with a lot of water.
- 2. Disinfect with chlorhexidin alcohol 5mg/mL or alternatively disinfected alcohol.

## Spill on intact skin.

- 1. Wash well with a plenty of water.
- 2. Further precautions are not necessary.

Contact immediately the Health Service at UiO for a blood test or if necessary treatment after injury.
