Always use gloves during analysis/ investigation when relevant:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) To protect yourself from chemical or biological contamination 2) To protect your samples from you contaminating the samples
Remove gloves and wash your hands:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) When your work is finished 2) On suspicion of contamination 3) When leaving the lab
Replace your gloves:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) On suspicion of contamination 2) When moving to another lab and you carry items which need protection or you need to protect yourself. <p>✓ Please use your elbow /wrist for opening doors, elevators etc.</p>
Never use gloves when:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Touching computer keyboards/ mouse, handlebars, radios, telephone, elevators etc. <p>✓ If you have to work in a mixed situation during examination, please keep one hand without glove for computer-work etc.</p>

- **Always be alert and aware of what you touch with your gloves to avoid contamination.**
- **If you have an accident, clean the area!**
