The user is the person who performs the work with ionizing radiation. He / she is responsible for following regulations for radiation, practices and procedures, and to ensure that his / her work does not lead to risk of injury to themselves or others health. Before working with radioactive substances the users must have adequate training.

The user is responsible for:

- Attending mandatory courses in radiation safety.
- Knowing well the work procedures and local instructions for working with radioactive substances.
- Following "Local guidelines for use of radioactive substances" at The Biotechnology Centre/NCMM.
- Following the procedure for purchase and reporting of isotopes.
- Delivering dosimeter to the person in charge of dosimeters when this is required.
- Following the instructions for use of UVC as a disinfectant (if in use).

All users must be familiar with the procedures for:

- Radiation safety coordinator
- Person in charge for dosimeters
- Group Leader
- Center Director
