Sensor guidance EXAM 2

The exam consists of two parts reflecting the topics in the two weeks of lecturing. The students need to pass both parts to pass the exam. In order to pass part two, two out of three questions need a passing grade.

In part one (Medicines in Global Society) students select one topic of their choice. In part two (Health Systems) student need to answer three out of five questions. Specific information is provided in each examination part.

Grades are awarded on a pass/fail scale. In addition to the outlined requirements given in the exam text, emphasis will be put on the following to obtain pass:

- specify which question you are answering at all times
- clear and distinct structuring in the answers
- language precision, critical reflection and independence are desirable
- syllabus must be used in the answers
- sources and citations should be used correctly.
- we expect a justification for why the student believes the choices they have made for their answers.

The grade not passed is given if:

- the formal requirements are not met
- the assignment has not been answered or is not answered correctly
- the thesis has a vague thematic focus and a deficient structuring
- shows weak theoretical understanding, inadequate analysis and low level of reflection
- Plagiarism is detected
