INTHE4114 – Epidemiology in Practice - Methodology, examples and tools

Examination in this topic is a group presentation at the end of the course.

The students are divided into groups of 3-4 persons. Each group will receive a specific research question approximately 12 days before the exam. Based on this, all members of the group should participate in the analyses of data, preparation of the presentation and in the final presentation of the group work at the exam. Each group has up to 10 minutes for the presentation, and thereafter the examiners will ask questions related to the presentation (5-10 minutes).

In the evaluation of the oral presentation of the group work in INTHE4114 the following will be emphasized:

- The formulation of a clear research question
- A brief and concise description of the study population and methods
- A clear presentation of the results with emphasize on the research question
- A prudent interpretation of the results
- A concluding remark
- Overall: A logical focus on the research question throughout

Grading: Pass/Fail.

In order to pass, you have to participate in the preparation and presentation of the group work. The group presentation should respond to the research question.
