Oral exam (student lecture)

Evaluation guidelines

The student will give a lecture on a topic related to health literacy that the student has worked on during the course.

The purpose of the student presentation is to present and reflect on the subject matter the student have inserted themselves during the course and communicate it to the other students and lecturers on an understandable and structured way. The student must show that he/she can explain how health literacy can be understood and explored through research.

Pass/fail is given.

When assessing the student lecture, emphasis is placed on:

- a clear, relevant and clearly delimited lecture topic related to health literacy
- well-founded choice of topic
- relevant choice and use of theoretical frame of reference
- ability for analysis and critical reflection
- that the content is presented in a clear way
- that the lecture has a logical structure and is adapted to the recipient group
- that the lecture stays within the defined time frame
- that the curriculum is used
- correct use of citations of sources

Fail is given if the candidate does not meet the academic minimum requirements

set in the course:

- the presentation has an unclear thematic focus and a deficient structuring
- the student has inadequate knowledge of the topic, shows weak theoretical understanding, little independence and low level of reflection
